

Students had a master class in butchery this week. Will Hough from our local butchers came in to show the students how to de-bone a whole chicken. Will showed the students all the different cuts of meat you can achieve from a chicken, he then showed them some of the favourite chicken products that they sell in the butchers.

The students were then given a whole chicken each and tasked to produce chicken wings, de-boned chicken thighs, drumsticks, and chicken breasts. They all did fantastically well despite some being a bit squeamish at the start.

We now have different cuts of chicken which we will be using over the next few weeks.


CHURCH STRETTON MAGPIES U13 FOOTBALL TEAM ADDITIONAL PLAYERS FOR SEASON 23/24.



INCREDIBLE!

You have missed very little learning and stand the best possible change of success. 97-100%

How much school will you have missed in a year?

> Fewer than 5 days

GOOD!

You have met our school target – well done. 96%

6 days missed

NEARLY THERE

This is almost 2 weeks of school missed. That's 50 lessons! 95%

9 days missed

IMPROVEMENT NEEDED

55 lessons missed across the year. 94%

11 days missed

CONCERN

This is known as persistent absence and will involve school action. It is the same as missing half a day of school every week. 90%

SIGNIFICANT
