Enrichment Week 15th - 19th July 2024

During enrichment week (last week of summer term) all students will be off their usual timetable and will be taking part in activities linked to curriculum areas. In addition to the residential trips taking place across enrichment week, the following activities are being offered with the aim of ensuring that every student has an experience off school site. These prices are heavily subsidised and include transport and entrance to the attractions in the hope that all students will be able to participate in the trips.

Blue planet Aquarium – Year 7 (Monday, 15th July) & Blist Hill Victorian town (Wednesday 17th July) Cost £30 (for both)

A captivating underwater world is waiting for you to discover at Blue Planet Aquarium. Home to more than 100 living displays, as well as one of Europe's largest collections of sharks, the aquarium offers plenty of marine life to marvel at. (Packed lunch required)

The Blists Hill Victorian Town living museum re-creates the life of a Shropshire industrial town of around 1900. The 50-acre site based on the old Madeley works site and is part of the Ironbridge gorge world heritage site. (Packed lunch required)

West Midlands Safari Park - Year 8 (Tuesday, 16th July) Cost £25

Discover it all through a tour of some of the world's most beautiful and endangered exotic animals. Explore a variety of exciting safari zones such as Elephant Valley, African Plains and Wild Africa, with animals that students will be able to see up close and personal. Students will also have full use of the adventure theme park, and with dozens of rides to choose from they are in for a thrill-seeking time. Arrive back at school for 5pm. (Packed lunch required)

Drayton Manor theme park and zoo – Year 9 (Thursday, 18th July) Cost £29.50 Enjoy the thrills and spills of rides such as Shockwave and Apocalypse or some more

tamer alternatives such as the river rapids. You will also get an opportunity to look around the Zoo and gardens. Arrive back at school for 6pm. (Packed lunch required)

To book a place on the trip please pay a non-refundable £5 deposit by Friday 14th June via ParentPay. The deadline for the remaining balance all of the above trips is Wednesday 3rd July 2024.
