### **Change of Supplier of School Uniform**

I am writing to inform you of a change to our school uniform suppliers from September 2018.

The change of supplier to Tesco is being introduced as feedback from some parents, via the parent survey (February 2016), mentioned the expense of the current logo'd uniform items.

The PE Department are also in the process of updating the current PE kit to include more robust and specialist items and you will be informed when this has been finalised. Non logo'd items can still be purchased from retailers such as Next, Tesco, Asda and Marks & Spencer's and our requirements have not changed.

Trousers: should be black, plain and straight not jeans or patch pocket.

Skirts: should be straight, black, plain and knee length. A pencil style is acceptable.

Shoes: black, sensible, not trainers.

The school has its own page on the Tesco Direct website where you will be able to order online and the uniform will be delivered to your home or work address, there is a £3.00 delivery charge and returns are free.

- All F&F uniform is ethically sourced and embroidered in the UK
- You are able to collect Tesco Clubcard points on every order placed
- The school receives a 5% cash donation on every order placed
