There are also two other trips available during the week, a year 8 water sports trip to Pembrokeshire and a Creative Arts trip for students in years 7, 8 & 9 to Dunfield House in Herefordshire.

**Sealyham Water sports (Pembrokeshire) 13-15<sup>th</sup> July 2026** [Sealyham - Active Learning Centres](#)

Sealyham Active Learning Centre is our dedicated coastal centre – but offers a whole range of outdoor activities both off, on and in the water. Situated conveniently for visits to numerous beaches and other coastal areas it provides the perfect setting for a fun-filled, action-packed residential experience. This three-day residential trip allows students the opportunity to enjoy the Welsh coastline and take part in activities such as surfing and coasteering.

## **Dunfield House Creative Arts (Herefordshire) 14-16<sup>th</sup> July 2026 [Dunfield House - Group Accommodation Centre in Herefordshire](#)**

The Creative Arts Department are offering a 2-night residential to Dunfield House, which is a residential centre in Kington, Herefordshire near to the Welsh border. It is set in beautiful countryside and boasts great food, 50 acres of green space and an indoor heated swimming pool! There will be time for collaboration, games, quizzes and even a party (fancy dress optional). Your child will have the opportunity to choose from a selection of music and drama activities that they will be participating in throughout their stay.

As always, trips will only run if there are sufficient numbers, are if they are oversubscribed, we will ensure that a fair “draw” takes place to allocate the required number of places and where necessary a waiting list will be operated. In addition to these trips there will also be in “school activities” as well as day trips for students who choose not to go on one of the residential trips during the enrichment week.
