For those students who are in school, we have been working hard to organise a wide range of exciting and enriching day trips that we hope all children will take part in. Each year group will have 2 days trips during the week. Year 7

Monday 13th July – Chester Zoo Transport and entry to the zoo, a chance to view animals from around the world and learn about conservation. More details about Chester zoo can be found [here](#).

Wednesday 15th July – Core-Padel centre (Birmingham) Transport to the centre, all equipment, expert paddle coaching finishing with a tournament. Padel is one of the fastest growing sports in the world and this is an opportunity to experience it first-hand. More information can be found [here](#).

Year 8

Monday 13th July – West midlands Safari Park Transport to the park, travel around the safari drive, entry to the park to see the other animals and a wristband that allows unlimited access to all the rides. More information about the park can be found [here](#).

Wednesday 15th July – Warwick castle Transport to the castle and entry including the shows that include birds of prey, archery and jousting. A packed lunch will be required. More information about the castle can be found [here](#).

Total cost of both trips: £43.50

Year 9

Tuesday 14th July - Thinktank (Birmingham science museum) Transport to Thinktank including entry to the museum and the planetarium. A packed lunch is required. More information about Thinktank can be found [here](#).

Thursday 16th July – Drayton Manor Transport to Drayton Manor theme park, access to both the theme park where you can enjoy all the rides and entry to the zoo. A packed lunch or money to buy food is required. More information about Drayton Manor can be found [here](#).

Total cost for both trips: £44

The aim of Enrichment Week is to ensure that all students have access to valuable out-of-school experiences. To support this, we have worked closely with providers to secure vastly reduced entry rates to all attractions. In addition, and as fuel prices have recently increased, the school is significantly subsidising the cost of transport. We hope that this additional support will ensure that **all students are able to take part in these opportunities**.

To support families further, we will be offering a staggered payment plan. **A deposit of £10 (non-refundable)** will be required initially by **Wednesday 29th April** so that we can confirm bookings with the attractions and transport companies. Further monthly payments will be required until the total cost is covered.
