Dear Parents/Carers,

As we move through the summer term, I would like to take the opportunity to remind you of the importance of students arriving at school each day fully equipped and ready to learn. Having the correct equipment makes a significant difference to students' organisation, engagement and success in lessons. Every student should bring a pencil case containing, as a minimum:

- A black or blue pen for writing
- A pencil
- A ruler
- A rubber

Where possible, students should also bring a glue stick and a green pen for self and peer feedback. All equipment should be brought to school each day in a suitable school bag so that students are prepared for every lesson.

I would also like to remind you of the school's expectations regarding jewellery. Our Uniform Policy states that students may wear a watch and pair of stud earrings. No other jewellery should be worn in school. If a student has a nose piercing, this must be removed or replaced with a clear retainer.

With this in mind, from Monday we will be carrying out checks on students wearing jewellery that is not permitted under the policy, including necklaces, hoop earrings, rings, bracelets and similar items. Any items that do not comply with the policy will be removed and taken to reception, where they can be collected by a parent or carer.

We would appreciate your support in discussing these expectations with your child and reinforcing the importance of arriving at school correctly equipped each day and adhering to our uniform and jewellery requirements.
